any party was elected and the parish paid the penalty over those 71 years without representation. In 1999, Eddie O'Meara, Ballydonnell was elected as an Independent Councillor. The coming election will be for a County Council to represent all of Tipperary. We'll need a strong voice to represent us if we are not to lose our influence in a much bigger pond.
